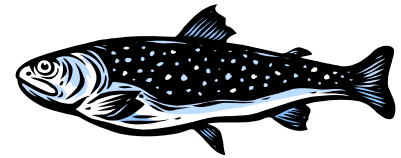
## **This Weekend at KYC**
